Welcome back to Term 4

Welcome back to another term of consistent work efforts – I hope everyone had the opportunity for a time of relaxation and are now ready for some hard work and learning consolidation that will culminate in excellent achievement at the end of the year. With their year coming to a rapid close, the Year 12 students should have spent a considerable amount of time during the break finishing assessment tasks – final External Assessment tasks are due to be submitted online next week for a number of subjects and final results are due at the SACE Board for the remainder of their work in the coming weeks.

During Week 4 and 5 of this term Examinations will be conducted for some subjects – the final date for exams – Friday 5 November. So, it can be seen that our students do not have very long to get all their work finished this term. We wish them well in their studies – remember that you have a long holiday ahead once all the work is finished and uploaded!

Stage 1/Year 11 Work Completion

As in previous years, the SACE Board has very tight timelines for the completion of both Stage 1 & 2 work in order to process results to be released to students prior to Christmas. All Stage 1 work must be completed and marked prior to all results being entered into Schools Online prior to Monday 29 November (Week 8). As a result, students will have completed all work requirements by the end of Week 7 and will no longer be required to attend lessons as all of their assessment will have ended.

It supports and reassures girls who are unsure, provides education on ways they can manage period pain themselves, and explains the steps to take if their pain is a problem. The team will visit Wudinna Area School on Thursday 11 November to address the girls from Year 9-11 (and any Year 12 girls who wish to attend as they will have finished their studies by this date).


Secondary SRC Announcement


