FROM THE PRINCIPAL G'day Everyone

We have had an interesting start to the year. Staff and students have been working hard in trying circumstances. We are very happy to have everyone back at school and students seem very happy to be back at school.

COVID

Rules around social distancing still apply. We also have our COVID Safe check in QR codes which everyone visiting the school must use. If you do not use QR codes we still maintain a written book in the Front Office to use. Everyone needs to sign in to ensure we keep our community safe.

Face masks are required for all adults when indoors (except for teachers if it's impeding their ability to communicate while teaching) and also students in Years 7 to 12 when indoors (including on school buses). Masks are strongly recommended for children in Years 3 to 6 when indoors. We are limiting the number of events and visitors to the school in line with the directive from the Department until the end of Week 4, 25 February when it will reassessed by the Department.

Facilities

- Repainting of the Reception classroom
- New whiteboards and furniture in several classrooms
- Removal and replacement of fretted pavers and relevelling of sunken pavers around the school

Welcome to the Ag Block for 2022. We have had an interesting start to the year, which has made getting the students busy a bit of a challenge. The Speckle Park cattle have transitioned well over the holidays and are happy to have students back on site because they have been getting goodies to eat from the fruit trees and vegetable plots. We are always happy to purchase or take donations of feed that you may have to spare (hay, straw or grain) for the Speckle Park cattle, so if you have some available please contact me through the school.

We would like to send out a huge thank you to 'Finke' North for assisting with the harvest of the school's crop last year. It was a massive help and greatly appreciated. This support allows us to continue to develop our Ag program and immerse the students in different fields of Agriculture.

This year the Year 6's have joined the Ag experience and will have two lessons per week focusing on Gardening/Ag. The Year 7's have also joined the Ag block and are working hard on researching and drawing plans for a yabby tank. Soon we will have the Merino wethers at school to begin our preparation on them for the SA Schools Merino Wether Competition in Adelaide on 7 September, which will be a focus for the Year 9's. The Year 11 students are working on farm biosecurity measures while the Year 12's are planning their external production investigations.

I look forward to another year ahead working with the students who bring an array of experiences to our lessons.

WHO CAN APPLY?


Wudinna Area School Parent & Friends are looking forward to the 2022 year ahead with new and continuing fundraisers that support our school.










Art with Mrs Phillips 'Object Drawings' A sample of some of the home learning that took place in Weeks 1 & 2 for our Year 3-5 students.
